COUNTERPART INTERNATIONAL'S *COMMUNITY & HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE PROGRAM* ANSWERS THE NEEDS OF BOARDING SCHOOLS IN ARMENIA

Yerevan -- On June 25, Counterpart International's *Community & Humanitarian Assistance Program* (CHAP) began distributing humanitarian assistance valued at over \$52,400 for a total of 1,509 children in several Armenian boarding schools. In response to an appeal from boarding schools in Yerevan, Byureghavan and Sisian, mattresses, pillows, cots and bed linens donated by the US Government are being distributed to the following institutions:

- Boarding Kindergarten # 14, Yerevan;
- Boarding School, Achapnyak;
- Boarding School #1, Yerevan;
- Boarding School #11, Yerevan;
- Boarding School for Pupils with Muscular-Skeletal Deficiencies, Yerevan;
- Boarding School for Children with Visual Defects, Yerevan;
- Boarding School #2, Yerevan;
- Boarding School, Byureghavan;
- Secondary Boarding School for Children with Visual Defects, Yerevan;
- Special Boarding School #13, Sisian.

Since opening in early December 2001, CHAP/Armenia has been instrumental in developing projects and proposals that alleviate human suffering. Having already distributed humanitarian commodities valued at over \$200,000 to 23,369 needy children in several Armenian boarding schools, CHAP intends to continue providing large quantities of humanitarian aid to children living and studying in these schools.
